

Code of Conduct

Please help us maintain the Colony Square experience. In order to provide a safe and enjoyable family-friendly environment, Colony Square property management asks that all patrons, employees, tenants, residents and guests be respectful of others and act responsibly while at Colony Square. During your stay, the following are prohibited:

- Using obscene language, shouting, and playing music without the use of headphones.
- Littering, defacing, or destroying property.
- Loitering in front of or blocking restaurants, offices, parking areas, sidewalks or common areas.
- Skating, skateboarding, hover-boarding, bicycle, riding on sidewalks, running, and climbing or standing on furniture or walls.
- Smoking, except in designated smoking areas.
- Distributing material, soliciting, demonstrating, conducting interviews, taking professional photos, videos or audio recordings (without prior Colony Square Management approval).
- Carrying a weapon of any kind, including firearms.
- Use of alcoholic beverages is restricted to designated areas.
- Only service animals are permitted inside buildings. Outdoors, pets must be under the control of the owner at all times. Owners are required to clean up after their pets.
- Colony Square Retail is open to the public 24/7, individual store hours vary. All visitors under the age of 17 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian after 8 pm.

ALWAYS LOOK YOUR BEST AND RESPECT OTHERS WHILE AT COLONY SQUARE BY FOLLOWING THESE SIMPLE GUIDELINES:

- No gang-related attire or activity, offensive clothing, tattoos, including that with obscene language or graphics.
- No apparel that obscures the face unless worn for cultural or religious reasons or medical conditions.
- No visible undergarments or clothing which exposes excessive portions of skins which may be viewed as inappropriate for a family-friendly environment.
- Panhandling or aggressive requests for money, food or other valuables.
- Motorcycles are not permitted in Colony Square parking deck. Motorcycles and scooters may only park on the Loading Dock designated spaces. Two-wheeled vehicles must be parked in designated areas. Vehicles or motorcycles deemed loud by management are not permitted on property.

Colony Square is a private property. Failure to comply with these rules and regulations and Federal State and local laws is grounds for exclusion from Colony Square. You may also be subject to prosecution under applicable laws.
